

## ACCESS TO FOUR BASS LAKE VIA MATABITCHUAN GENERATING STATION

Ontario Power Generation (OPG) is currently replacing penstocks and making other repairs to Matabitchuan Generating Station. Heavy equipment is on site and travelling frequently between the generating station and the headworks located on top of the hill at Four Bass Lake.

OPG's contractor, Barclay's Construction, has implemented a traffic control plan, to ensure public and employee safety.

Effective immediately, all vehicles travelling between the generating station and Four Bass Lake will be required to stop at Barclay's Construction site trailer. Barclay's will ensure the area is clear prior to travel and in some cases, may escort the public. The same procedure will apply to vehicles traveling back towards the station. At this time, work is scheduled to take place weekdays from 7:30am to 4pm. The contractor however reserves the right to work outside of those hours, at which point the traffic control plan would apply during those times. Signage should be in place on-site with detailed instructions. Travelers can expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Parking near the headworks at Four Bass Lake is limited. Currently, there are no restrictions. However, OPG reserves the right to limit parking on its property at the headworks should issues or abuses occur. Priority will be given to property owners. All other users may be turned away. To ensure this doesn't happen, when parking at the headworks, please be considerate of others. Do not impede traffic or access to the site.
